<u>1 point</u>

- Twelve students received one point each for failing to complete the required *Think About It* Orientation course
- Thirty students received one point each for under-age possession of alcohol
- Sixty four students received one point each for participation in a disruptive party in a residence hall room

2 Points

- Twelve students received two points each for under-age consumption of alcohol in a public area
- Two students received two points each for hosting a disruptive party in a residence hall
- Two students received two points each for possession of a false ID

3 Points

- Four students received three points each for theft of food from a dining hall after the facility was closed
- One student received three points for hosting a party with alcohol attended by under-age students
- One student received three points for possession of Nun-Chucks. A violation of the weapons policy

<u>4 points</u>

- Three student received four points each and were required to pay double the cost of repair after vandalizing college property. The students reported the damage to Campus Safety the next day, thereby avoiding suspension
- Four under-age students received four points each for hosting a party with alcohol and serving other under-age students
- One student received four points for violation of the College's fire safety policy, use of holiday lights

5 Points

• One student received five points for harassing drivers as they drove up College Hill Road by jumping into the street as they approached.

6 Points

- One student received six points for possession of drug paraphernalia and violation of the College's fire safety policy use of candles in a residence hall room
- Four students received six points each and were required to pay double the cost of repair after deliberately vandalizing College property and reporting it to Campus Safety the next day
- One under-age student received six points for hosting disruptive party in a residence hall and serving alcohol to under-age students

8 Points

• One student received eight points for possession of marijuana and psychedelic mushrooms

10 Points

- One student received 10 points and was suspended for one semester for two separate instances of under-age possession of alcohol and possession of marijuana
- One student received 10 points, was suspended for one semester and charged double the cost of repair for destroying ceiling tiles in a residence hall. The student did not report the damage to Campus Safety or Residential Life.
- One student received 10 points and was suspended for one semester for starting a bon fire in close proximity to a residence hall and burning college owned materials.
- One student received 10 points and was suspended for two semesters for driving up College Hill Road while under the influence of alcohol
