

Fall '19 and Spring '20 Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions

Finding of Not Responsible after a Hearing Process

- 21 Students were found not responsible through the Administrative Hearing Process

One Point

- Three students received 1 point each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Three students received 1 point each for Failure to Comply with a College Official
- Eight students received 1 point each for vaping inside residence halls
- Five students received 1 point each for failing to complete required training

Two Points

- Three students received 2 points each for Disruptive Conduct
- One student received 2 points for Harassment
- Five students received 2 points each for possessing a fake ID
- Two students received 2 points each for Failure to Comply with a College Official
- One student received 2 points for Lew or Indecent Conduct
- Four students received 2 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Twenty-three students received 2 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Five students received 2 points each for a violation of the COVID-19 Social Distancing Policy
- One student received 2 points for acquiring an excessive number of parking tickets

Three Points

- Thirteen students received 3 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- One student received 3 points for Disruptive Conduct
- One student received 3 points for attempting to use a fake ID
- One student received 3 points for possession of a fake ID and for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- One student received 3 points for Disruptive Conduct and Failure to Comply with a College Official
- Two students received 3 points each for Unauthorized Room Changes

Four Points

- One student received 4 points for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- One student received 4 points for a violation of the Drug Policy
- One student received 4 points for Damaging Personal or College Property

- One student received 4 points for Actions that Endanger the Health and Safety of Any Person
- Eleven students received 4 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy

Five Points

- Two students received 5 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy and Disruptive Conduct

Six Points

- Four students received 6 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy and the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 6 points for hosting a disruptive party with bulk alcohol
- One student received 6 points for a violation of the Alcohol Policy and Fire Safety Policy

Seven Points

- One student received 7 points for a violation of the Weapons and/or Fireworks Policy

Eight Points

- No students received 8 points this academic year

Nine Points

- One student was assigned 9 points for Actions that Endanger the Health and Safety of Any Person

Ten Points - Suspension

- One student was suspended for two semesters after a finding of responsibility for two counts of Failure to Comply with College Officials, and one count each of Actions that Endanger the Health and Safety of Any Person and Disruptive Conduct.
- One student was assigned 3 points for Falsification or Misuse of Any Document. This student accumulated more than 10 points so they were suspended for one semester.

Ten Points - Expulsion

- No students were expelled this academic year
