

Fall '20 and Spring '21 Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions

Finding of Not Responsible after a Hearing Process

- 18 Students were found not responsible through the Administrative Hearing Process

One Point

- Twenty-eight students received 1 point each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Nine students received 1 point each for failing to complete required training
- Three students received 1 point each for Unauthorized Possession of Keys or Unauthorized Entry
- Two students received 1 point each for Failure to Comply with College or Public Officials

Two Points

- Two students received 2 points each for possession of a fake ID
- Four students received 2 points each for Disruptive Conduct
- Three students received 2 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Nine students received 2 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Four students received 2 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy while in a substance-free residence hall
- Two students received 2 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy

Three Points

- Four students received 3 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- One student received 3 points for walking on the roof of a residence hall
- Two students received 3 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy

Four Points

- Two students received 4 points each for Damaging Personal or College Property
- Five students received 4 points each for Unauthorized Possession of Keys or Unauthorized Entry
- One student received 4 points for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- One student received 4 points for a violation of the Community Agreement and Damaging Personal or College Property

Five Points

- One student received 5 points for Damaging Personal or College Property and for violating the Community Agreement

Six Points

- Two students received 6 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 6 points for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property

Seven Points

- One student received 7 points for Damaging Personal or College Property

Eight Points

- One student received 8 points for a violation of the Drug Policy and a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 8 points and was removed from campus housing for Failure to Comply with the COVID-19 Community Standards Agreement and conduct that is likely to have a substantial adverse effect on, or pose a threat to any person

Nine Points

- No students received 9 points this academic year

Ten Points - Suspension

- Two students were suspended for 1 semester each for several violations of College Policies, Rules or Regulations including providing false information to Campus Safety, violating COVID-19 policies and violations of the Alcohol Policy
- Two students were suspended for 1 semester each due to violations of the Community Agreement and conduct that is likely to have a substantial adverse effect on, or pose a threat to any person
- One student was suspended for 2 semesters for a violation of College Policies, Rules or Regulations and for conduct that is likely to have a substantial adverse effect on, or pose a threat to any person
- One student was suspended for 1 semester for two counts of Theft or Possession of Stolen Property and for Damaging Personal or College Property
- One student was suspended for 1 semester for two counts of Theft or Possession of Stolen Property, Damaging Personal or College Property, a Fire Safety Policy violation and a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- One student was suspended for 2 semesters for two counts of Theft or Possession of Stolen Property, Damaging Personal or College Property, a violation of the Community Agreement and Abuse of the Judicial Process

Ten Points - Expulsion

- No students were expelled during this academic year

Other Sanctions

- One student had their degree held for one year as a result of a DWI and damage to property
