

Fall '21 and Spring '22 Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions

Finding of Not Responsible after a Hearing Process

- 68 Students were found not responsible through the Administrative Hearing Process

One Point

- Eight students received 1 point each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- One student received 1 point for Failure to Comply with a College Official
- Four students received 1 point each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- One student received 1 point for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Nine students received 1 point each for failing to complete required training

Two Points

- One student received 2 points for a violation of the Alcohol Policy and Failure to Comply with a College Official
- Three students received 2 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Three students received 2 points each for possessing a fake ID
- One-hundred and sixty-nine students received 2 points each for Failure to comply with COVID-19 testing protocol, including a missed required COVID-19 test
- Three students received 2 points each for Lewd or Indecent Conduct
- Four students received 2 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Thirty-one students received 2 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Two students received 2 points each for Failure to Comply with a College Official
- One student received 2 points for failing to complete Health Center requirements
- One student received 2 points for a violation of the Pet Policy

Three Points

- Forty-two students received 3 points each for Failure to comply with COVID-19 testing protocol, including a missed required COVID-19 test
- One student received 3 points for a violation of the Drug Policy and a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 3 points for Abuse of the Judicial Process
- Three students received 3 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- One student received 3 points for Conduct that is likely to have a substantial adverse effect on, or pose a threat to any person
- One student received 3 points for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy

Four Points

- One student received 4 points for a violation of the Computer Abuse Policy
- Twenty students received 4 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 4 points for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Two students received 4 points each for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- One student received 4 points for Lewd or Indecent Conduct
- One student received 4 points for Failure to Comply with College or Public Officials
- One student received 4 points for Failure to Comply with College or Public Officials and for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 4 points for Failure to Comply with the COVID-19 Community Standards Agreement and Failure to Comply with College or Public Officials

Five Points

- Two students received 5 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Ten students received 5 points each for Disruptive Conduct
- One student received 5 points for Damaging Person or College Property
- One student received 5 points for multiple violations of the Fire Safety Policy
- Two students received 5 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy and a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Four students received 5 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and for Failure to Comply with a College or Public Official

Six Points

- One student received 6 points for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- Two students received 6 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and for Failure to Comply with a College or Public Official

Seven Points

- One student received 7 points for conduct that is likely to have a substantial adverse effect on, or pose a threat to any person
- One student received 7 points for Damaging Personal or College Property

Eight Points

- One student received 8 points for missing several required COVID-19 tests

Nine Points

- Three students received 9 points each for missing several required COVID-19 tests

Ten Points - Suspension

- One student was suspended for 2 semesters for driving while intoxicated and causing damage to College property

Ten Points - Expulsion

- No students were expelled during this academic year

Other Sanctions

- One student was found responsible for Conduct that is likely to have a substantial adverse effect on, or pose a threat to any person and was required to change rooms to a different location on campus.
- One student was found responsible through a Judicial Board hearing for Failure to comply with COVID-19 testing protocol, including a missed required COVID-19 test and was assigned 20 hours of community service.
