

Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions
Fall '22 and Spring '23

Finding of Not Responsible after a Hearing Process

- 35 Students were found not responsible through the Administrative Hearing Process
- One student was found not responsible through the Judicial Board Hearing Process

Warnings Issued for 1st Time Fire Safety Violations

- 31 students received warning letters for first-time fire safety violations

One Point

- Thirteen students received 1 point each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Ten students received 1 point each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- One student received 1 point for Lewd or Indecent Conduct
- Two students received 1 point each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Six students received 1 point each for Failing to Comply with a College Official

Two Points

- Two students received 2 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Five students received 2 points each for possessing fake IDs
- Fifteen students received 2 points for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Three students received 2 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- students received 2 points each for
- Six students received 2 points each for Failing to Comply with a College Official
- One student received 2 points total for a violation of the Alcohol Policy and a violation of the Drug Policy
- Two students received 2 points each for violations of the Drug Policy and for smoking indoors

Three Points

- Two students received 3 points each for Failing to Comply with a College Official
- One student received 3 points for possessing and using a fake ID
- One student received 3 points for Disruptive Conduct and Failing to Comply with a College Official
- Five students received 3 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 3 points for a violation of the Drug Policy

- One student received 3 points for a violation of the Alcohol Policy and Failing to Comply with a College Official

Four Points

- Thirty students received 4 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 4 points for Disruptive Conduct

Five Points

- Seven students received 5 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 5 points for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and for causing substantial damage to College property
- One student received 5 points for Disruptive Conduct and for Unauthorized Entry
- One student received 5 points for Conduct that is Likely to Have a Substantial Adverse Effect on, or Pose a Threat to Any Person

Six Points

- Two students received 6 points each for Unauthorized Entry and Failing to Comply with a College Official
- One student received 6 points for Falsification or Misuse of Any Document or ID
- One student received 6 points for a violation of the Weapons and Fireworks Policy
- One student received 6 points for Disruptive Conduct, Lewd or Indecent Conduct and Conduct that is Likely to Have a Substantial Adverse Effect on, or Pose a Threat to Any Person

Seven Points

- No students were assigned 7 points

Eight Points

- One student was assigned 8 points for violations of the drug, alcohol and fire safety policies

Nine Points

- One student was assigned 9 points for violations of the drug, alcohol and fire safety policies

Ten Points - Suspension

- No students were suspended this academic year

Ten Points - Expulsion

- One student was expelled for disruptive behavior and making a threat against members of the College community
