

Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions
Fall '23 and Spring '24

Finding of Not Responsible after a Hearing Process

- 56 Students were found not responsible for at least one charge after a hearing process

Warnings Issued for 1st Time Fire Safety Violations

- 218 Students received warning letters for first-time fire safety violations

One Point

- Six students received 1 point each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Five students received 1 point each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Two students received 1 point each for failing to submit required documentation to the Health Center
- Twelve students received 1 point each for failing to complete the required Sex Discussed Here orientation session
- Nine students received 1 point each as a second warning for failing to complete the required Sex Discussed Here orientation session
- Four students received 1 point each as a third warning for failing to complete the required Sex Discussed Here orientation session
- Three students received 1 point each as a fourth warning for failing to complete the required Sex Discussed Here orientation session
- One student received 1 point as a fifth warning for failing to complete the required Sex Discussed Here orientation session
- One student received 1 point for failing to comply with the ESA agreement
- Two students received 1 point for unauthorized access to a residence hall roof

Two Points

- Fifteen students received 2 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Six students received 2 points each for possessing fake IDs
- One student received 2 points for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Two students received 2 points each for unauthorized access to the Green Waste Site
- One student received 2 points for failing to complete the required Sex Discussed Here orientation session
- Two students received 2 points each for failing to comply with a College official
- One student received 2 points for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and Failure to Comply

Three Points

- Four students received 3 points each for violations of the Alcohol Policy
- One student received 3 points for an unapproved pet in a residence hall room

- Twelve students received 3 points each for violations of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 3 points for a violation of the Weapons Policy
- One student received 3 points for a violation of the Drug Policy
- One student received 3 points for Conduct that was Inconsistent with the Values, Expectations, and Standards of a Hamilton Student.
- One student received 3 points for Disruptive Behavior and a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- One student received 3 points for violations of the Fire Safety Policy and Alcohol Policy

Four Points

- Ten students were assigned 4 points each for theft or possession of stolen property
- Five students were assigned 4 points each for smoking marijuana in a residence hall bathroom
- Eight students were assigned 4 points each for Disruptive Conduct
- Four students were assigned 4 points each for violations of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student was assigned 4 points for Damaging Personal or College Property
- One student was assigned 4 points and an educational session for violating the Fire Safety and Drug Policies
- Four students were assigned 4 points each for Unauthorized Access to a residence hall roof
- One student was assigned 4 points for a violation of the Weapons Policy
- One student was assigned 4 points for Disruptive Conduct and Damaging Personal or College Property

Five Points

- Two students were assigned 5 points for violating the Drug Policy
- One student was assigned 5 points for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and Failure to Comply
- One student was assigned 5 points for participating in a disruptive party in a public space with alcohol

Six Points

- Three students were assigned 6 points for hosting a disruptive party off-campus
- One student was assigned 6 points for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and the Drug Policy
- One student was assigned 6 points for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- One student was assigned 6 points for violating the Fire Safety Policy, Noise Policy and for unauthorized access to a residence hall roof
- One student was assigned 6 points for being disruptive and causing damage to College property
- One student was assigned 6 points for a violation of the Pet Policy and for causing damage to College property

Seven Points

- No students received 7 points during this academic year

Eight Points

- One student was assigned 8 points for a fire safety violation and possession of stolen property

Nine Points

- No students were assigned 9 points

Ten Points - Suspension

- No students were suspended this academic year

Ten Points - Expulsion

- No students were expelled this academic year
