

Fall '21 and Spring '22 Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions

Finding of Not Responsible after a Hearing Process

- 32 Students were found not responsible through the Administrative Hearing Process

Warnings Issued for 1st Time Fire Safety Violations

- 303 Students received a warning for first time Fire Safety violations

One Point

- Thirteen students received 1 point each for a violation of the Drug Policy
- Three students received 1 point each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Ten students received 1 point each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Twenty students received 1 point each for accumulating an excessive number of parking tickets
- Nineteen students received 1 point each for failing to complete required training
- Two students received 1 point each for possessing alcohol in a Substance-Free residence hall

Two Points

- Two students received 2 points each for a violation of the Alcohol Policy
- Two students received 2 points each for Failure to Comply with a College Official
- Four students received 2 points each for possessing a fake ID
- Forty-two students received 2 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- One student received 2 points for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy and a violation of the Drug Policy
- Three students received 2 points each for accumulating an excessive number of parking tickets
- Six students received 2 points each for accumulating an excessive number of parking tickets and for failing to register their car with Campus Safety
- One student received 2 points for Conduct that is inconsistent with the values, expectations and standards of a Hamilton Student

Three Points

- Two students received 3 points each for Failure to Comply with a College Official
- One student received 3 points for Unauthorized Entry
- Eight students received 3 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Two students received 3 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy and a violation of the Fire Safety Policy

- Two students received 3 points each for an unauthorized room change and for providing false information to Campus Safety
- Five students received 3 points each for accumulating an excessive number of parking tickets
- Four students received 3 points each for accumulating an excessive number of parking tickets and for failing to register their car with Campus Safety

Four Points

- One student received 4 points for a violation of the Alcohol Policy and Failure to Comply with a College Official
- Two students received 4 points each for a violation of the Drug Policy and a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Twenty-two students received 4 points each for a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Eleven students received 4 points each for Intentionally or Recklessly Damaging Private, Public or College Property
- Three students received 4 points each for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- Three students received 4 points each for accumulating an excessive number of parking tickets and for failing to register their car with Campus Safety
- One student received 4 points for violations of the Pet Policy

Five Points

- One student received 5 points for a violation of the Drug Policy and a violation of the Fire Safety Policy
- Two students received 5 points each for Theft or Possession of Stolen Property
- One student received 5 points for a violation of the Drug Policy and for Intentionally or Recklessly Damaging Private, Public or College Property
- One student received 5 points for violations of the ESA Agreement and Policy

Six Points

- One student received 6 points for a violation of the Weapons and/or Fireworks Policy
- One student received 6 points for accumulating excessive parking tickets and providing false information to Campus Safety

Seven Points

- One student received 7 points for a violation of the following policies
 - Conduct that is inconsistent with the values, expectations and standards of a Hamilton Student
 - Violation of College Policies, Rules or Regulations (2 counts)

Eight Points

- No students received 8 points during this academic year

Nine Points

- No students received 9 points during this academic year

Ten Points - Suspension

- No students were suspended during this academic year

Ten Points - Expulsion

- One student was expelled after a finding of responsible through a Judicial Board hearing for violations of the following policies
 - Conduct that is inconsistent with the values, expectations and standards of a Hamilton Student
 - Intentionally or recklessly damaging private, public or College property
 - Interfering with the Freedom of Expression of Others
 - Violation of College Policies, Rules or Regulations
