- 2. A statement clearly specifying the expected role of your supervisor in this study (frequency and purpose of meetings with supervisor, anticipated laboratory, studio, or field assistance, etc).
- **3.** A statement clearly outlining your obligations in this study (preparation for meetings with supervisor, paper type and length, lab notebook, portfolio or finished products, anticipated deadlines, etc).
- 4. A statement clearly describing how the study will be evaluated. List all required coursework and specify how it will be weighed in determining final grade (include percentages whenever possible). If you are applying for a two-term independent study, indicate how each term's grade will be determined.
- 5. A one-paragraph evaluation of the project by the supervisor of the independent study.
- 6. A signed application form. When you have completed your proposal, take it to each individual indicated below for her or his review and signature. Read the regulations in the college catalogue that apply when the supervisor is an off-campus person who is not a member of the Hamilton faculty.

After all signatures are obtained, please submit the full proposal to the Dean of Students' Office during the term preceding that of your proposed study or, in exceptional circumstances, by the end of the add period of the term of the proposed study. *Incomplete applications will not be accepted*.
